The complaint was filed by the defacto-complainant stating that his husband is living separately due to family issues and her son divorced his wife and on 22.03.2024, at about 03.00 p.m she got call from his friends that he drowned into water under the influence of alcohol and he was later found dead and so lodged a complaint. After completion of investigation, the final report was referred as Further Action Dropped (FAD) and it was taken on file in RCS.No.293/2024. Notice which was sent to Defacto-complainant through RPAD was returned as addressee absent/enquiry and so notice was couldn't be able to be served through available means. On perusal of final report and based on the complaint, it is found that the son of the Defacto-complainant drowned in the canal under the influence of alcohol and died and there seem to be no suspicion in the death of the Defacto-Complainant's son and so further investigation is not necessary in this case. Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances, the final report referred as Further Action Dropped (FAD) is accepted and entire proceedings in this case is closed. The concerned Police is directed to not make any further investigation regarding this case.
