This petition is filed by the learned advocate Thiru.K.Thangarajan,M.Com.,B.L., this court.
After considering that petition, this court delivered the following

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/Accused seeking bail under section 480 of BNSS.

Respondent Police has filed a case against Petitioner/Accused in Cr.No. 160/2026 U/s. 305(a),331(4) of BNS. Petitioner/Accused stated in the petition he committed offences as alledged. The said offences are non-bailable one. He is in Judicial custody from 14.05.2026. The petitioner has no connection whatsoever to this case, and the case filed against the petitioner is false. Petitioner is the only bread winner of his family. Hereafter, he will not abscond anywhere. He ready to abide court any condition.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted that in this case the Investigation is pending. Already one case filed in Sathyamangalam Police Station Cr.No.527/2008,482/2008 U/s. 457,380 and He is in Judicial custody from 23.05.2026 and he is in judicial custody. Further more, cases under Sections 457 and 380 of the IPC are registered against the petitioner at police stations including Melmaruvathur, Valparai, Annur, Karamadai, Thudiyalur, Podanur, and Ooty. petition on

the grounds that the petitioner is a habitual offender prone to engaging in theft, and there is a likelihood of him committing further acts of theft if released on bail. May be this petition is allowed because the Petitioner may to the same kind of offense again and again and upsconding this Court. So the Prosecution side strongly opposes to Hence this Petition may be dismissed.

Petition and case records perused accused was custody from 14.05.2026 to past 34 days. Hence this petition stands allowed and the petitioner is enlarged on bail on the following conditions :-

1. Petitioner/Accused shall appear before this court regularly and conduct the case.
2. The petitioner shall not tamper the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
3. The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
4. Petitioner/Accused shall produced one suretie with satisfaction of this court and execute bond Rs.10,000/-
5. Petitioner/Accused shall signature before the Respondent Police Station daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 05.00 p.m for 30 days.
