After considering that petition, this court delivered the following

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/Accused seeking bail under section 480 of BNSS.

Respondent Police has filed a case against Petitioner/Accused in Cr.No. 451/2016 U/s. 392 r/w 34 of IPC. Petitioner/Accused stated in the petition he is not committed any offences as alledged. He is in Judicial custody from 12.05.2026. After being released on bail, the petitioner has been summoned and is currently appearing in the court. The case is being heard. The petitioner has been suffering from liver inflammation and lung congestion, and is unable to work due to kidney failure. He is also undergoing treatment for diabetes and asthma. Therefore, he was unable to appear in court on 12.05.2026 due to hospital treatment. Therefore, the court issued an arrest warrant for the petitioner and the Sathyamangalam Police arrested the petitioner. The petitioner has been in the custody of the Honorable Court since 22.05.2026. The petitioner is ready to furnish sureties as demanded and will abide by any condition imposed by this Court. The offences against the petitioner are non-bailable offences. Petitioner is the only bread winner of his family. Hereafter, he will not abscond anywhere. He ready to abide court any condition.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submitted that in this case the Investigation is pending. In the above case, an NBW was issued and executed as the petitioner did not appear in court on time. And has been in judicial custody since 22.05.2026. The trial of the case has been stopped midway as the petitioner did not appear in court on time. So the Prosecution side strongly opposes to allow this petition because the Petitioner may to the same kind of offense again and again. Hence this Petition may be dismissed.

Petition and case records perused accused was custody from 22.05.2026 to past 18 days. And also Petitioner/Accused ready to accept any condition that imposed by this Court. Hence this petition stands allowed and the petitioner is enlarged on bail on the following conditions :-

1. Petitioner/Accused shall appear before this court regularly and conduct the case.
2. The petitioner shall not tamper the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
3. The petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
4. Petitioner/Accused shall produced two sureties with satisfaction of this court and execute bond Rs.10,000/-
5. Petitioner/Accused shall signature before the Respondent Police Station daily twice at 10.30 a.m and 05.00 p.m for 30 days.
