This petition has been filed on 05.11.2019 and came up for final hearing before this court on 03.06.2026 in the presence of Advocates Thiru.C.Subramaniam for Petitioner, Thiru.M.Arjuna n for 1st Respondent, and Thiru.R.Mohanbabu for 2nd Respondent. Heard the arguments of Both, Perusing the case records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this tribunal delivers the following:

ORDER

1. This petition is filed by the petitioner under Section 166 of M.V Act claiming compensation of Rs.20,00,000/- for the injuries caused to her in the road accident on 16.12.2016.

2. **The brief averments of the petition:-**

On 16.12.2016 at about 12.00 PM while the petitioner traveled in the motor cycle bearing Registration No. TN-56-E-5991 as a pillion rider along Kanjikoil to Perundurai road, from North to South direction and while nearing Ravi shop a van bearing Registration No. TN-38-AQ-1760 driven by 1st respondent came from the East to West slip road, in a rash and negligent manner, without any indication and suddenly dashed against the motor cycle and caused an accident. Due to the accident the petitioner was

thrown from the vehicle and she sustained multiple injuries all over the body. The petitioner was admitted at Sudha Hospital, Erode for treatment as inpatient. The petitioner is aged 58 years and was working as Tailor and earning not less than Rs.20,000/- per month. The 1st respondent is the driver cum owner of the vehicle, and 2nd respondent is the Insurer of the vehicle and both are liable to pay compensation to the petitioner jointly and severally.

3. The brief averments of the counter filed by 1st respondent read as follows:

The petition is not sustainable. The age, occupation, income, period of treatment, disability are to be proved by the petitioner. The petitioner has not disclosed the true facts about the accident. The accident is admitted but the manner of accident is denied as false and incorrect. The vehicle was duly insured with the 2nd respondent and if any compensation is payable, the 2nd respondent being the insurer is liable to pay compensation.

4. The counter filed by 2nd respondent read as follows:

The petition is not sustainable. The age, occupation, income, period of treatment, disability are to be proved by the petitioner. The petitioner has not disclosed the true facts about the accident. The accident is admitted but the manner of accident is denied as false and incorrect. The 1st respondent driven the vehicle in a slow and cautious manner in proper direction and the rider of the two-wheeler suddenly crossed the road and contributed for the accident. The owner and insurer of the two-wheeler are proper and necessary parties to the proceedings. The petitioner has not wore helmet which resulted in head injuries. The 1st respondent was not possessed with

valid driving license and as such it is violation of policy condition which the 2nd respondent is not liable to indemnify. The alleged treatment and disability are all denied as falls and incorrect. There is no merits in the petition and prays for dismissal.

5. Points for consideration

- a) Whether the accident was due to the rash and negligent driving of van bearing Registration No. TN-38-AQ-1760 by 1st respondent ?
- b) Whether the petitioner is entitled to get any compensation?
- c) Who is liable to pay compensation?
- d) What is the quantum of compensation that the petitioner is entitled to?

6. To prove the case of the petitioner, she has examined herself as PW1 and Ex.P1 to Ex.P12 was marked. No oral and documentary evidence adduced on the side of respondents. The Medical board report issued by the Medical Board before the Government medical College Hospital, Erode at Perundurai was marked as Ex.C1.

7. The application filed by 2nd respondent under Section 170 of Motor Vehicle Act was allowed in I.A.No.4 of 2026 dated 24.04.2026.

8. Documents perused and arguments of both heard.

9.Point No.1

It is the case of petitioner that while she traveled in the two wheeler as pillion, due to the rash and negligent driving of the van bearing Registration No. TN-38-AQ-1760 by its driver/owner 1st respondent the accident has taken place. FIR regarding the accident was registered against

1st respondent. The petitioner had pleaded negligence upon 1st respondent. The manner of accident and negligence pleaded was not challenged by respondents and there was no contra evidence as regard the contention put forth in the counter that the accident is due to the negligence of the two-wheeler rider. The 1st respondent was not examined to prove the fact that he exercised due care and caution and there was no negligence on his part. The documents produced by petitioner under Ex.P7 shows Police after investigation had filed Final report against 1st respondent. The 1st respondent also admitted his offence and convicted. There is no contra evidence as regard the manner of accident and evidence of the petitioner as to negligence on the 1st respondent is reliable, convincing and satisfactory. Accordingly the tribunal concludes the accident has taken place due to the negligence of 1st respondent and point No.1 is answered in affirmative.

10. Point No.2

After the accident, the petitioner was admitted at Sudha Hospital, Erode for treatment as inpatient from 16.12.2016 to 27.12.2016 (12 days) and 09.02.2017 to 13.02.2017 (5 days) as per Ex.P10. Wound certificate was marked as Ex.P4. Medical examination reports was marked as Ex.P11. From Ex.P4 and P10 the petitioner sustained Acute SDH – right FTP region, right ankle foot chip fracture medial cuneiform. The petitioner undergone craniotomy and also cranioplasty. The petitioner was treated conservatively for the ankle fracture. Medical bills was produced under Ex.P9. As such the petitioner is entitled for compensation.

11. Point No.3

The 1st respondent is the Registered owner/driver of the van bearing

Registration No. TN-38-AQ-1760 and 2nd Respondent is the Insurer of the vehicle under policy certificate No.1706043115P116270191 valid till 29.03.2017. Though the copy of the policy was not produced, the 2nd respondent has not disputed the details of policy mentioned in the petition and the MVI report. There is no violation of policy or registration certificate conditions pleaded and proved. The petitioner is third party as regard 1st respondent vehicle is concerned. As such the 2nd respondent being insurer of the 1st respondent is liable to indemnify the 1st respondent in respect of compensation payable to the petitioner. The liability of the respondents 1& 2 are joint and several.

12. Point No.5

a) Age and Income of the petitioner:-

The petitioner has stated her age to be 58 years at the time of accident. The Aadhar card of the petitioner marked as Ex.P12 shows her date of birth as 03.03.1957. If the said details is taken into consideration her age at the time of accident would be 59 years. Accordingly the age of the petitioner is determined as 59 for the purpose of the claim. The petitioner has pleaded that she was working as Tailor and earning Rs.20,000/- per month. However no documents produced regarding proof of income. The occupation was not disputed. In the absence of any documents as to income, the tribunal is of view the notional income has to be taken into consideration and considering the period of accident of the year 2016, the tribunal fix the monthly income of the petitioner as **Rs.7,000/-** per month.

b) Disability

After the accident, the petitioner was admitted at Sudha Hospital,

Erode for treatment as inpatient from 16.12.2016 to 27.12.2016 (12 days) and 09.02.2017 to 13.02.2017 (5 days) as per Ex.P10. Wound certificate was marked as Ex.P4. Medical examination reports was marked as Ex.P11. From Ex.P4 and P10 the petitioner sustained Acute SDH – right FTP region, right ankle foot chip fracture medial cuneiform. The petitioner undergone craniotomy and also cranioplasty. The petitioner was treated conservatively for the ankle fracture.

Further , the petitioner subjected herself for assessment of disability by a duly constituted Medical Board before the Government Medical College Hospital, Erode at Perundurai. Ex.C1 is the Disability Certificate dated 29.08.2024 issued by the Medical Board. In Ex.C1, it is found noted the petitioner has disability of 10% neurological disability and 20% Ortho disability. If the disability was taken into consideration by applying the formula $a + b \div 90$

90 , the total partial permanent disability of the petitioner is 28%. The disability was not assessed for whole body and it is partial permanent disability confined to the head and lower limb of the body. The tribunal during evidence has not observed the petitioner has any difficulty in her daily activities. There is no evidence or material to show the petitioner suffered any permanent /functional disability and lost her future earning capacity. The assessment of disability was not challenged by 2nd respondent. Considering the nature of injury, this Tribunal is inclined to accept the disability assessed by the Medical Board.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the Tribunal is of the considered opinion that percentage method for computation of compensation in respect of disability may be adopted. Applying the guidelines framed by the Honourable Madras High Court to the facts of the case, and taking note

of the date of accident having taken place in the year 2016, this Tribunal is of view that Rs.4,500/- may be awarded for 1% of the disability and thus a sum of **Rs.1,26,000/-** is awarded for 28% of the disability.

c) Medical expenses:

The petitioner has produced medical and hospital bills to the tune of Rs.3,52,640/- under Ex.P9. The 3rd respondent has not disputed the correctness of the medical bills and there was no contra evidence. Accordingly the petitioner is entitled for a sum of **Rs.3,52,700/-** (rounded off) on the head of medical expenses.

d) Loss of income:

Due to the accidental injuries the petitioner could have continued her avocation for a period of five months and accordingly tribunal is inclined to award a sum of **Rs.35,000/-** on the head of loss of income.

e) Pain and suffering:

After the accident, the petitioner was admitted at Sudha Hospital, Erode for treatment as inpatient from 16.12.2016 to 27.12.2016 (12 days) and 09.02.2017 to 13.02.2017 (5 days) as per Ex.P10. Wound certificate was marked as Ex.P4. Medical examination reports was marked as Ex.P11. From Ex.P4 and P10 the petitioner sustained Acute SDH – right FTP region, right ankle foot chip fracture medial cuneiform. The petitioner undergone craniotomy and also cranioplasty. The petitioner was treated conservatively for the ankle fracture. In view of the injuries the petitioner would have suffered severe pain and suffering. Hence a sum of **Rs.50,000/-** is awarded towards pain and suffering.

f) Other heads:

i) The petitioner would have incurred expenses for transportation and accordingly tribunal is inclined to award a sum of **Rs.12,000/-** on the head of transportation expenses.

ii) The petitioner sustained injuries and suffered disability and as such she would be in need of additional nourishment and therefore the Tribunal is inclined to award **Rs.10,000/-** in this aspect.

iii) The petitioner would have sustained damage to cloths and accordingly tribunal is inclined to award **Rs.1,300/-** towards damage to cloths.

iv) Due to the injuries sustained by the petitioner, she would forego certain amenities at present and future and would also have required the assistance of attender for a period of 2 to 3 months. Considering these facts **Rs.63,000/-** is awarded towards loss of amenities , discomfort and attender charges.

v) The petitioner has not claimed any amount on the head of future medical expenses. The petitioner has not substantiated the need of future medical expenses or she was under continuous medical treatment by any evidence. Accordingly no amount is awarded on the head of future medical expenses.

vi) On the discussion made above, the compensation as apportioned under various heads is awarded as below.

1. Disability	-	Rs.1,26,000
2. Pain and suffering	-	Rs. 50,000
3. Transportation expenses	-	Rs. 12,000
4. Additional nourishment	-	Rs. 10,000
5. Damages to the clothes	-	Rs. 1,300
6. Loss of amenities & attender charges	-	Rs. 63,000
7. Medical expenses	-	Rs.3,52,700
7. Loss of income	-	Rs. 35,000

Total compensation	-	Rs.6,50,000/-
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In fine, the petitioner is entitled to a sum of **Rs.6,50,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only)** as just and fair compensation and the point is answered accordingly.

12. The petitioner has to produce the attested copy of the 1st page of his bank passbook, PAN card and the xerox of the Aadhar card as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in CMA.No.428/2016 dated 11.03.2016 reported in 2016 (1) TNMAC 433 (DB).

13. In the result,

a) The petition is allowed in part with proportionate cost against the Respondents 1 and 2. Awarding the total compensation of **Rs.6,50,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only)** including interim award passed if any, payable with interest at 7.5% per annum from the date of presentation of the petition.

b) The 2nd respondent being the insurer of 1st respondent vehicle is directed to deposit the said compensation amount with interest and cost directly to the bank account of the petitioner as directed by the Honourable Apex Court in the decision **Parminder Singh /Vs/ Honey Goyal and others dated 18.03.2025** within one month from the date of award after ensuring the payment of balance court fees by the petitioner. The petitioner and 2nd respondent are directed to file compliance memo on receipt of the compensation amount.

c) The petition is dismissed with regard to the rest of the claim amount.

d) The advocate fee is fixed at **Rs.13,500/-** Court fee for the award amount is **Rs.5,873/-**. The deficit court fee of **Rs.4,842/-** shall be paid by the petitioner within two weeks from the date of order. No interest is awarded for the period when the petitioner defaulted, as per orders if any and also for the period when the petitioner failed to pay the Court fees as directed.

e) A free copy of the award shall also be delivered to the parties on request within 15 days as per section 168(2) of the MV Act and Rule 20(6) of the Rules.

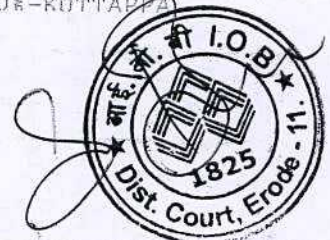
