SHO report received. Arguments heard on the application for releasing Tractor Trolley bearing Registration No.HR92A-7573 on supardari. Perusal of the case file shows that the instant case was registered for commission of offence punishable under Sections 303(2) of BNS and 21(1), 21(4)A of MMRD Act 1957 in which the vehicle in question was taken in possession. Thereafter the report of the SHO concerned was called for. In its report, the SHO concerned has reported that said vehicle alongwith RC is lying in the Police Station and submitted that they have no objection if the vehicle is released to the original owner on supardari. Photocopy of RC placed on record. It is considered that no fruitful purpose is served by keeping the vehicle in custody. So in these circumstances, the above said vehicle lying in the police custody is ordered to be released on superdari to the applicant on furnishing of superdaginama and surety bond in the sum of Rs.30,00,000/-. **Requisite Superdaginama and surety bond not furnished.** Papers be tagged along with the challan.
