Petition filed u/s.437 Cr.P.C, Dt: 05.06.2024 to relax the bail.

This Petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru. K.Vijayalakshmi, B.A., B.L., Learned Advocate for the petitioners and Tmt. P.Kayalvizhi, Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent and upon hearing both sides this court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

This Condition Relaxation Petition was filed by the Accused by stating that the above petitioners/accused were charged for offenses **U/s. 392 IPC** by the respondent police and they granted bail on 06.04.2024 by this Hon'ble Court with a condition to appear and sign before this respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M. until further orders and that above named petitioners/accused obeyed the bail condition till today. Further it was submitted that the petitioners/accused undertake to appear as and when require by this Humble Court.

Hence the petitioners/accused humbly prays that the Hon'ble Court may be pleased to order to relax the bail condition imposed against them and allow them to appear on receipt of summons and thus render justice.

The Police and APP filed their formal objection by stating that the above case investigation is pending. In this stage if the condition is relaxed they may abscond and tamper the witnesses. Hence pray to dismiss the condition relaxation application.

Records perused considering the fact that the above case and also considering the fact that accused (A1, A2) had complied the bail condition till date and also considering the fact that accused (A1, A2) have got no criminal history and also considering the petitioners are the only breadwinner of their family and also considering the fact that the above condition imposed against the accused is hereby relaxed on following conditions.

1. The Petitioners/Accused shall appear and sign before the Bhavani Police Station on Monday and Thursday for 6 weeks at 10.30 AM without fail.

2. The Accused shall appear in court on summons.

**Accordingly this Condition relaxation Petition is allowed.**
