This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru.N.Muthuvel, Advocate appearing for the petitioners and the Learned Public Prosecutor Thiru.S.Sathiamoorthy, on behalf of the complainant and this court passed the following,

ORDER

Petition for Anticipatory Bail.

The Petitioners have filed this petition under section 438 of CrI.P.C., praying to grant anticipatory bail to them for the alleged offences under sections 417, 420, 493, 313, 506(i) of IPC in Cr.No.32/2022 of Kumbakonam All Women Police Station.

Heard both sides. Perused the records.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioners contended that the petitioners have not committed any offences as alleged, but, they have been falsely implicated in this case as A2 to A4 and they are having permanent abode and also ready to abide any condition imposed by this court and hence, it is prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The Learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the de-facto complainant Saranya married A1 on love affairs and their marriage was held at Ayyanar kovil situated at Kabisthalam in the presence of the friends of A1-Viswa and after two months, she became pregnant and on knowing it, the relative of A1 viz.A2-Rani who is maternal junior mother of A1, A3-mother of A1, A4-Amulu who is the sister of A1, aborted her fetus by administering tablet into her, for which, she was hospitalized in a dangerous condition and

recovered from it after treatment and thereafter A2 to A4 came to the parental house of the de-facto complainant and criticized her by way of informing about her love affairs with A1 to her parents and street residents and further, A1 also came and abused her with filthy language which induced her to commit suicide by jumping into the river, however, she was rescued by somebody and informed her parents and in turn her parents come and brought her and investigation is still pending and hence, it is objected to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners as against the woman hailing from very poor background, the role of the petitioners in causing abortion of fetus of the victim, which is very serious in nature, non-completion of investigation strong objections raised on the side of the prosecution and as there is no change in circumstances after dismissal of the earlier anticipatory bail petition, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners.

In the result, this Anticipatory Bail Petition is dismissed.
