This petition is, coming on this day for final hearing before me on 14.05.2026 in the presence of **Mr. K.Harishkumar** Advocat, the learned counsel for the petitioners and having perused the records and having stood over the same for consideration, this court on this day delivers the following,

ORDER

2. List of the Petition:

This is an petition filed U/s. 187(3) of BNSS seeking mandatory bail. The accused stands charged for the offence punishable U/s. 304(2) of BNS iin Cr.No.14/2026 Kallakurichi PS and they were remaded on 26.03.2026 The petitioners contend tha tthey have been in judicial custody for the past 62 days and

they are entitled to be enlarged on bail u/s.187(3) BNSS as the respondent police has not yet filed the charge sheet in this case within 62 days from the date of filing of FIR.

3. The Point to be determined is : Whether this petition is to be allowed or not?

In this case the petitioners/accused were arrested and remained in judicial custody 13.03.2026 for the offence punishable under section 304 (2) of BNS. For the offence punishable U/s. 304 (2) the maximum imprisonment is 03 years. The petitioners have been in judicial custody for the past 62 days. So far Final Report is not filed in this case. Hence, the petitioner / accused are entitled for statutory bail and this petition is allowed on the following conditions, that the petitioners shall

1. Execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for like sum.
2. Not commit the offences similar to the alleged offences in the case.
3. Tamper with the evidence and shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person as to dissuade him from disclosing facts to the court or police.
4. Sign before the Kallakurichi Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders and co-operate with investigation.
