This petition has come up today before this court in the presence of Tr.U.Tamil, counsel for the petitioner and Tr.M.Visva Bharathi, Public Prosecutor for the respondent police. After hearing both side, perusing the averments, this Court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

Heard both sides.

This petition has been filed by the counsel for the petitioner u/s.483(1)(b) of BNSS Act, seeking relaxation of the condition imposed on the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.295/2026 dated 23.01.2026.

2] The learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner by this Court in CrI.M.P.No.295/2026 dated 23.01.2026 with a condition to sign before the respondent police station daily at 9.00 A.M, until further orders. Accordingly, the petitioner has complied the condition for the past 30 days without any violation. Now, prayed to relax the condition totally.

3] The learned Public prosecutor submitted that the petitioner has been complied the condition for the past 30 days without any violation and he further submitted that in this case, investigation is almost completed but charge sheet is yet to be filed.

4] Considering the above said aspects, having regard to the period of compliance, nature of offence and also considering the other circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to relax the condition totally which is already imposed on the petitioner. Further, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Court concerned on all the hearing dates without fail.

In the result, this petition is allowed and conditions imposed on petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.295/2026 dated 23.01.2026 is hereby fully relaxed.
