This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this Court in the presence of Tr.A.Elayaraja, the counsel for the petitioner and Learned APP Grade-II appearing for the State and having perused the records, heard both parties and having stood over the same for consideration, this Court on this day delivers the following,

**ORDER**

1. This Petition has been filed by the petitioner u/s. 451 of Cr.P.C. to pass an order of returning the RC Book of vehicle mentioned in the petition bearing Reg.No.TN-54-Q-6365 i.e., Tipper Lorry to the petitioner as interim custody to the petitioner.

2. The petitioner is the owner of the petition mentioned property bearing Reg. No. TN-54-Q-6365 i.e., Tipper Lorry and seized by the respondent police alleging that the petition mentioned property was used for the commission of offences U/s. 379 of IPC. It is further submitted that the petition mentioned property was produced before the Hon'ble Principal Sessions Court, Krishnagiri and the above said court already released the vehicle

in CrI.M.P. 3004/2022 dated 09.12.2022 and he is need the Original RC Book for obtaining fitness certificate from RTO Office, without obtaining the FC the above mentioned vehicle unable to run road and he facing great difficulties and other expenses without running the vehicle. It is further submitted that it is just and necessary to allow the petition and pass an order to return the petition mentioned property as interim custody to the petitioner.

3. Per contra, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor has raised an objection that, if the R.C book is return to the petitioner/accused, he may be again commit the similar offence or change the nature of the property or sale the property. Hence, she prayed to dismiss the application.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Perused available materials on record. The petitioner has been alleged offences u/s.379 of IPC in connection with Cr.No.847/2020 on the file of Inspector of police, Krishnagiri Taluk Police station, Krishnagiri. The petitioner was arrested and remanded judicial custody and subsequently he granted bail by this court. The petition mentioned property was seized by the respondent police and thereafter the said vehicle has ordered to be returned subject to condition that the original RC book stands in the name of petitioner to be produced before this court and same is in the court custody. The learned counsel for petitioner would submit that the period of FC in the petition mentioned property has been expired and it is just and necessary to return the original RC book as interim custody.

5. On the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor has raised an objection, if the original RC Book is returned to the petitioner, he may be again committed similar offence or change the nature of the property or sale the property and he will not produce the same before this

court and so he prayed to dismiss the petition. Considering the above facts and circumstances and submissions put forth the learned counsel for the petitioner, this court is inclined to return the original RC Book subject to following condition.

(i) The petitioner shall produce the original RC Book stands in the name of petitioner for the vehicle i.e., Tipper Lorry bearing Reg.No: TN-54-Q-6365 on or before 16.04.2026.
