This petition is coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Tr. G. Kathiravan the counsel for the petitioners and Learned APP appearing for the State and having perused the records, heard both parties and having stood over the same for consideration, this court on this day delivers the following.

ORDER

1.This petition has been filed by the petitioner U/s. 483 (1) (b) of BNSS seeking relaxation of the condition imposed on the petitioner/accused in Crl.M.P. No.526/2025, Dated 26.12.2025.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioner/accused has committed offences U/s.381 IPC and the petitioner has filed the bail application and the same was granted by this court in Crl.M.P. No.526/2025, Dated 26.12.2025 with a condition that the petitioner/accused shall appear and sign before this Court every morning at 10.00 A.M. for 3 Months and the petitioner has followed the above said condition without any violation. It is further submit that the petitioner/accused has followed the condition till date without fail and

he undertakes that he will appear before this court as and when requires till the disposal of the case. Accordingly, he prayed to totally relax the condition.

3. Per contra, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor would submit that he may be again commit the same offence or abscond or tamper the witness. Accordingly he prayed to dismiss the application.

4. Heard both side and perused materials available on record. On perusal of records, the petitioner/accused has been surrendered before this Court on 26.12.2025.

5. Considering the above facts and circumstances the period of condition complied by the petitioner/accused and there is no previous antecedents against the petitioner/accused, this court is inclined to relax the conditions totally. According this petition is hereby allowed, the condition which is imposed by this court is totally relaxed.
