This Petition coming on this day before me in the presence of Mrs.C.Gomathi Counsel for Petitioner/Accused and the learned APP for prosecution and upon perusal of the case records and upon hearing the arguments on both sides this court passed the following:

**ORDER**

1. The petition is filed under section 480 of BNSS by the petitioner seeking grant of bail for the offence under section 303(2) of BNS.

**2. The contents in the bail Application :-**

The petitioner has been arrested by the respondent and remanded to custody on 16.02.2026 by this court for alleged offence U/s.303(2) of BNS. The accused are not guilty of any offence and did not commit the said offence. The accused is wrongly implicated. The said offence is non bailable in nature. The accused is a law abiding citizens and the accused will not abscond. The liberty of the accused is essential to arrange the defense. The accused is ready to furnish substantial sureties to the satisfaction of this court to enlarge the accused on bail. Hence the petition.

**3. Reply of Respondent/Prosecution in brief:**

Reply received from the police concern, Investigation of this case is pending. If the accused are enlarge on the bail. He may be again commit the same offence or abscond or tamper the witness. Hence strongly oppose to enlarge the accused on the bail.

#### **4.Point for consideration:**

Point for consideration in this petition is that, whether the Petitioner is entitled to be enlarged on bail as prayed for?

#### **5.Discussion:**

Heard. Records perused. The counsel for the petitioner has stated that it is a falsely foisted case and that the petitioner is innocent person and further undertook to provide sufficient sureties and to abide by any conditions of this court. Considering the aspect that the petitioner has been in Judicial custody for 30 days, considering the aspect property was recovered from the accused, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner/Accused to be released on bail.

i) The Petitioner/Accused is released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with 2 sureties each for the same amount.

ii) The Petitioner/Accused shall appear and sign before Respondent Police station Morning at 10.00 AM for 30 days upon his release.

iii) The Petitioner/Accused shall cooperate for the investigation and the trial.

iv) The Petitioner/Accused shall not hamper the witness and tamper the evidence.

v) The Petitioner/Accused shall not abscond during the pendency of the case.

In the result, this petition is allowed.
