

Order dated 19.04.2023

The 04 accused persons on court bail are present by filing hajira.

On the previous occasion a petition was filed wherein both the parties acknowledged an amicable settlement. The complainant reiterated on dock that better sense prevailed and the dispute had been settled amicably. This is a case under sections 341/323/506/34 IPC and hence the situation in hand comes under the purview of section 320 Cr.PC.

Hence, it is

ordered

that the case stands compounded and the 04 accused persons namely 1) Nitai Naskar son of Late Bishnupada Naskar, 2) Bablu Naskar son of Late Bishnupada Naskar, 3) Sanaka Naskar @ Saneka wife of Nitai Naskar and 4) Moumita Naskar daughter of Nitai Naskar; Ghunimeghi, PO- B. Narayanpur, PS- Bhangore, South 24 Parganas are acquitted of the charges u/s 341/323/506/34 of IPC as per provision laid down in the section 320(8) Cr PC. The two accused persons are discharged from the bail bonds along with the sureties. No order is passed u/s 452 of the Cr PC as nothing has been seized by the IO.
