This petition is filed by Advocate Thiru A. Madhankumar, praying to  
relax the condition imposed on the petitioners previously.

ORDER

Heard both side. Perused the petition.

2. Offences alleged u/s 296(b), 132 and 351(2) of BNS and Sec. 3 of TNPPDL Act.

3. The petitioners 1 to 3 were granted bail by this court on 10.02.2026 in CrI.M.P. No.449/2026 with condition that the petitioners should appear and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 A.M. until further orders.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners 1 and 2 have been complying the condition from 14.02.2026 and the 3<sup>rd</sup> petitioner has been complying the condition from 15.02.2026, except on 01.03.2026 due to his illness and due to the condition, they are unable to do their regular works and prayed that the condition may be relaxed.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application and submitted that the petitioners 1 and 2 have been complying the condition from 14.02.2026 and the 3<sup>rd</sup> petitioner has been complying the condition from 15.02.2026, except on 22.02.2026 and the investigation is not yet over.

6. Considering the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners/accused and also considering the duration of compliance of condition and the stage of investigation, this court is inclined to modify the condition.

7. In the result, condition is modified that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent police weekly once i.e on every Monday at 10.00

A.M. until further orders and accordingly this petition is partly allowed.
