ORDER

Heard both side. Perused the petition.

2. Offences alleged u/s 303(2) of BNS and Sec. 21(1) of MMDR

Act.

3. The petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this court on  
18.02.2026 in CrI.M.P. No. 461/2026 with condition that the petitioner should  
appear and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 A.M. until further

orders.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition from 20.02.2026 and prayed that the condition may be relaxed.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application and submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition only from 20.02.2026 and the investigation is not yet over.

6. Considering the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner/accused and also considering the duration of compliance of condition and the stage of investigation, this court is inclined to modify the condition.

7. In the result, condition is modified that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police weekly once i.e on every Monday at 10.00 A.M. until further orders and accordingly this petition is partly allowed.
