ORDER

Heard both sides. Perused the petition.

2. Offence alleged u/s 333, 296(b) and 109(1) of BNS @ u/s 333,  
296(b) and 103(1) of BNS.

3. The petitioner was granted bail by this court on 08.12.2025 in CrI.M.P.No. 4267/2025 with condition that the petitioner should stay at Viluppuram, appear and sign before the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Viluppuram daily at 10.30 A.M. until further orders and subsequently, the condition was modified by this court on 12.01.2026 in CrI.M.P.No. 23/2026 that the petitioner should appear and sign before the Judicial Magistrate No.I, Nagercoil daily twice at 10.30 A.M. and 5.00 P.M. until further orders and thereafter, the condition was modified by this court on 27.01.2026 in CrI.M.P.No. 210/2026 that the petitioner should appear and sign before the respondent police weekly once i.e. on every Monday at 10.30 A.M. and 5.00 P.M. until further orders.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been complying the modified condition from 02.02.2026 and due to the condition, he is unable to do his routine works and prayed that the condition may be relaxed.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner has been complying the modified condition from 02.02.2026.

6. Considering the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner/accused and also considering the duration of compliance of condition, this court is inclined to relax the condition.

7. In the result, condition is totally relaxed and accordingly this petition is allowed.
