before the Vacation Sessions Court, Kanniyakumari at Nagercoil as Crl.M.P.
No.278/2026, praying to relax the condition imposed on the petitioners and
subsequently it was transferred to this court and renumbered as Crl.M.P.
No.1454/2026.

ORDER

Heard both side. Perused the petition.

2. Offences alleged u/s 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS.

3. The petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this court on 06.01.2026 in CrI.M.P. No.9/2026 with condition that the petitioners should appear and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders and subsequently, the condition was modified by this court on 16.02.2026 in CrI.M.P. No. 541/2026 with condition that the petitioners should appear and sign before the respondent police weekly once i.e, on every Monday at 10.00 A.M., until further orders and thereafter, the condition was modified by this court on 27.03.2026 in CrI.M.P. No. 997/2026 with condition that the petitioners should appear and sign before the respondent police monthly once i.e, on 1st day of every month at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners 1 & 2/A1 & A3 have been complying the condition from 01.04.2026 and the 3rd petitioner/A4 has been complying the condition on 01.04.2026 and on 05.04.2026 he met with a road accident and he sustained fracture on his hip and he is under treatment and so on 01.05.2026 he did not comply the condition and the case has been charge sheeted and prayed that the condition may be relaxed.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application and

submitted that the petitioners 1 and 2 have been complying the condition on 01.04.2026 and 01.05.2026 and the 3rd petitioner has been complying the condition only on 01.04.2026.

6. Considering the argument of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the case has been charge sheeted and also considering the duration of compliance of condition, this court is inclined to relax the condition.

7. In the result, condition is totally relaxed and accordingly this petition is allowed.
