condone the non compliance of condition by the petitioner.

ORDER

Heard both side. Perused the petition.

2. Offences alleged u/s 296(b), 115(2), 118(2) and 351(3) of
BNS.

3. The petitioner was granted bail by this court on 24.04.2026 in CrI.M.P. No.1277/2026 with condition that the petitioner should appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M., until further orders.

4. It is stated in the petition that the petitioner has been complying the condition from 28.04.2026 and due to his illness, he did not comply the condition on 02.05.2026, 04.05.2026, 10.05.2026 and 28.05.2026 and prayed that the non compliance of condition by the petitioner may be condoned.

5. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application and submitted that the petitioner has been complying the condition only from 28.04.2026 and on 02.05.2026, 04.05.2026, 10.05.2026 and 28.05.2026 he did not comply the condition and the investigation is not yet over.

6. Considering the reason stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused, this court is inclined to condone the non compliance of condition by the petitioner.

7. In the result, non compliance of condition by the petitioner on 02.05.2026, 04.05.2026, 10.05.2026 and 28.05.2026 is condoned and accordingly this petition is allowed.
