This petition is filed by Advocate Thiru R. Jawahar Lal, u/s 482
of BNSS, praying to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

ORDER

No representation for the petitioner. Heard the learned Public
Prosecutor. Perused the petition.

2. The petitioner/accused alleged to have committed the offences u/s 85, 316(2), 351(1) of BNS and Sec. 3, 4 and 6 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. The petitioner was already granted interim anticipatory bail till 06.04.2026 subject to conditions and also directed the petitioner and defacto complainant to appear before the Mediation Centre, Nagercoil on 18.03.2026 at 11.30 A.M. and other subsequent dates to be fixed by the Mediators for mediation.

4. Mediation Report received. As per the Mediation Report, dated: 30.04.2026 received from the Mediation Centre, Nagercoil, mediation between the parties completed and both the parties agreed to settle the matter amicably in Mediation and the petitioner Mr.Jeyaraj and defacto complainant Mrs. Jenitta are not interested to continue their marriage and the petitioner Jeyaraj returned all her jewels (39 1/2 sovereigns) to the defacto complainant and he paid Rs.5,00,000/- at the time of marriage to the defacto complainant and give back all her household articles and the defacto complainant is agreed to settle the case pending before the Magistrate Court, Kuzhithurai and also DOP No. 937/2025 filed by the petitioner before the Family Court, Padmanabhapuram will be settled by both through court. Considering the fact that the matter is settled before Mediation, there appears

to be no necessity for custodial interrogation, this court is inclined to allow this application.

5. In the result, the interim anticipatory bail already granted to the petitioner/accused by this court on 05.03.2026 is made absolute and accordingly this petition is allowed.
