The petitioner and respondent being husband and wife filed this petition under section 10(1)(x) of Indian Divorce Act, for dissolution of their marriage and for costs.

This petition is coming on 14-07-2026 for orders before me in the presence of Sri J.Raju, Advocate for petitioner, and of Sri C.V.Ramakrishna Rao, Advocate for respondent, upon perusal of material on record and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:-

O R D E R

The petitioner and respondent being husband and wife filed this petition under section 10(1)(x) of Indian Divorce Act, for dissolution of their marriage and for costs.

1. The petitioner and respondent being husband and wife filed this petition under section 10(1)(x) of Indian Divorce Act, for dissolution of their marriage. Matter is referred to mediation center to settle the terms. Terms of compromise before mediation center received. Heard.

A. It is agreed between the petitioner and respondent by dissolving their marriage held on 02-09-2021, between the petitioner and the respondent, took

place at BalajiTirupathi Rao Kalyana Mandapam, Ongole, as per Christian caste and customs that they should live separately.

B. The petitioner paid an amount of Rs. 15 lakhs to the respondent towards full and final satisfaction of her maintenance and permanent alimony in MC. No.37/2023 on the file of Hon'ble Judge, Family Court, Ongole.

C. Both parties declared that they were not blessed with any children during their wedlock.

D. The respondent agreed that she will not claim any maintenance on her behalf from the petitioner in present and future in any circumstance.

E. The respondent agreed that, she will not claim any right in the properties of the petitioner and his family members in future.

F. Both parties agreed that they will not file any civil or criminal cases against each other with regard to this dispute.

G. It is agreed by both the parties that they will lead their life as per their wish after obtaining decree of divorce from the Honorable Court in the above OP without interfering in the personal life of each other in any manner.

H. The petitioner and the respondent agreed that they were relinquished their wife and husband status against each other.

I. The respondent agreed to withdraw the CC.No.2801/2022 on the file of III Addl. Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Ongole against the accused and his family members and the respondent also agreed to withdraw the MC.37/2023 on the file of Hon'ble Judge, Family Court, Ongole.

2. Considering the representation of the counsel for petitioner and respondent coupled with terms of compromise in mediation center, Ongole dt. 11.07.2026, the petitioner and respondent are entitled for divorce.

3. In the result, petition allowed, in terms of mediation center, Ongole dt. 11.07.2026 by dissolving the marriage between the petitioner and respondent.
