"Both parties are present. On negotiation, both parties have agreed for settlement of the dispute for a sum of Rs. 3,70,000/- /-(Rupees Three

Lakhs Seventy Thousand Rupees only)

The respondent/s is/are directed to deposit the settled amount in the competent court within six weeks from the date of this award, failing which the respondent/s agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award amount from today till the date of deposit.

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with the Sections 21/22 E of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987.

As and when the award amount is deposited in the court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner/s through NEET/RTGS, as per the directions of the High Court of Madras, in CMA No.428/2016, in the bank account of the petitioner/s as given below:
