NBWs on behalf of accused.*

Present: Sh. Imran Hamid, Ld. Counsel for accused.

Accused present through VC.

Ld. Counsel for accused has moved an application for cancellation of NBWs on behalf of the accused on the ground that accused is a resident of Sultanpur and could not travel to court due to ill health of child. Medical documents of child are annexed with the said application. Further, his non-appearance before the court is neither deliberate nor intentional. It is further submitted that accused has made the payment of Rs.10,000/- to the complainant on 13.01.2026 pursuant to settlement talks with the complainant.

Submissions heard.

In the interest of justice and in view of the submissions, NBWs issued against the accused are stayed till NDOH i.e. **12.08.2026** with a warning that he shall appear on each and every date of court proceedings, subject to the condition that he shall furnish bail bonds in compliance of order dated 26.11.2025 and pay previous cost of Rs.2,000/- to the complainant on the NDOH.

Let the matter be put up on date already fixed i.e.
12.08.2026.
