This Suit is filed for granting compensation for damages of Rs.20,000/- against the defendants and the same may be recovered from the defendants and declarating the resolutions in the letter dated 24.11.2002 and 07.12.2022 be null and void, and for Permanent injunction restraining the defendants from giving effect to the letter dated 07.12.2022 or passing any more resolution which will be prejudicial to the interest over the plaintiff and for costs.

The cause of action for the suit arose on 28.03.2002; being the date of nomination of the plaintiff as the treasurer of the manalikkarai R.C.Street, oor committee, and on 24.11.2002; being the date of defamatory letter issued by the defendants and on 27.11.2002; being the date of threat by the 1st defendant and his associate to the plaintiff and on 02.12.2002; being the date of suit notice and on 07.12.2002; being the 2nd letter of the defendants with illegal resolutions against the plaintiff and the same arose at kothanaloor village of kalkulam Taluk which is within the territorial jurisdiction of this Honourable Court.

For the purpose of jurisdiction and damages is valued at Rs.20,000/- (Rs.Twenty Thousand Only) and a court fee of Rs.1500.50ps is paid under section 22 of the Tamil Nadu Court Fee Act and Suits Valuation Act XIV of 1955 and declaration is valued at Rs.400/- and a court fee of Rs.30.50/- is paid under section 25(d) of the act and consequential to 'B' prayer and no separate court fee need to be paid.

This suit is coming before me for final hearing in the presence of Adv.Alwin Vethamoni, Learned counsel for the Plaintiff and Adv. A.P.Rajan Learned counsel for the Defendant No.1 and Defendant No.2. Upon perusal of records stood over for consideration till this day, this court doth order and decree as follows.
