ATMA NAND MEHTA Vs HONEY SINGH

Present: Complainant in person.

Arguments heard.

A perusal of the file shows that the present application has been filed for registration of FIR by the complainant. As per the contents of the complaint and the argument of the petitioner, he had approached SHO P.S. Farakpur by way of a written complaint but no meaningful action was taken on the same. However as per the case file and the arguments of the petitioner himself, he has not yet approached S.P. Yamunanagar in order to fulfil the requirement of Section 173(4) read with 175 (3) of BNSS as per which he should first avail the remedy of approaching the Superintendent of Police concerned and if, even after that no action is taken then the aggrieved person can approach the court under Section 175(3) BNSS. Since the above requirement has not been fulfilled in the present matter, I find no ground to proceed under Section 175(3). Accordingly, the present application stands *disposed of* with the direction to the petitioner to approach S.P. concerned first and satisfy the requirement under Section 173(4). If he is still aggrieved, then he shall be at liberty to file a fresh application under Section 175(3) of BNSS or for any other relief allowed by law including a private complaint.
