It is incorrect that neither I entered the GD entry No.22 nor I remained posted in P.P. City Solan. It is incorrect that Ex.P-61/PW13 is a fabricated document.

PW-14 Statement of HC Manoj Negi No.110, I.O. Police Post Dagshai, Police Station Dharampur, District Solan, H.P.

04.08.2026

During the year 2024, I remained posted as Head Constable/I.O. in SIU, Solan. On 26.12.2024, I alongwith HC Dinesh, C. Puneet and C. Ajay was on patrolling duty in the City Limits of Solan in official vehicle being driven by HHC Bheem. At around 6:00 PM, when we were present near Police Post Saproon, I received a secret information that a person by the name of Dheeran residing in a building of Neeraj situated at Kaleen, Ward No.13, Solan is indulged in the trade of Charas. I got this information reduced into writing which is Ex.P-26/PW5 through HC Dinesh and sent it to Dy.S.P. Solan through C. Puneet. Then we went to Kaleen at the house of Neeraj at 6:30 PM. In the verandah we found two persons talking to each other. I disclosed to them about the secret information and associated them for the purpose of search of the house of accused Dheeraj. The names of those witnesses are Neeraj and Anshul. Then we went to Room No.4. I and HC Dinesh simultaneously knocked the door, on which Dheeraj came out. Accused Dheeraj is the same person who is visible on the video screen. I disclosed to him about the secret information. Thereafter, we including the independent witnesses gave our search to the accused vide memo Ex.P-1/PW1. Then we entered inside the room. I searched the room on which I found two beds, one of the bed was in the direction of the bathroom. On that bed there was a bag lying on the pillow side. There were four zips in that bag. On unzipping the last column of the bag there were three square articles wrapped with light yellow micron bags. On checking the substance inside those micron bags it was detected to be Charas. On weighment, it was measured to be 1.212 Kgs. The entire Charas alongwith micron bags in which it was wrapped was sealed in a cloth

parcel with three seals of impression 'Z', which was marked as 'A-I'. The bag in which these micron bags containing Charas was found was sealed in another cloth parcel with three seals of impression 'Z', which was marked as 'A-II'. Thereafter, I filled the NCB forms in triplicate. I have also took specimens of the seals on separate cloth pieces, one of which is Ex.P-2/PW1. Thereafter, the aforesaid sealed parcels alongwith NCB forms and sample seals were seized vide memo Ex.P-3/PW1. Thereafter, I prepared the information Ex.P-24/PW3 regarding seizure of the contraband for registration of the case and sent it to police station Sadar Solan through C. Ajay Pal. The entire proceedings of search and seizure were done by C. Ajay Pal. After the registration of the case, HC Balbir arrived at the scene. I handed over the case property contained in the aforesaid sealed parcels, all the documents relating to search and seizure and the custody of the accused to HC Balbir vide memo Ex.P-40/PW12.

At this stage, Ld. PP produced one cloth parcel sealed with three Court seals, with a request to open the same. Seals are intact. Request considered and allowed.

On opening the same, two transparent pouches containing black substance and three brown tapes over polythene and one yellow micron bag came out. The Charas Ex.MO-4 and Ex.MO-5 was wrapped in the brown tapes Ex.MO-2, Ex.MO-3 and Ex.MO-10 which were there inside the micron bag Ex.MO-7, which was placed inside the other bag found lying on the bed of the accused Dheeraj. These articles were sealed in parcel Ex.MO-1.

At this stage, Ld. PP produced another cloth parcel sealed with two Court seals, with a request to open the same. Seals are intact. Request considered and allowed.

On opening the same, a bag came out. Bag Ex.MO-9 is the same in which the micron bag Ex.MO-7 containing plastic

tape wraps Ex.MO-2, Ex.MO-3 and Ex.MO-10 containing Charas Ex.MO-4 and Ex.MO-5 was there. It was sealed in a parcel Ex.MO-8.

XXX Cross examination by Sh. Maneesh Sharma, learned counsel for the accused. XXX

It is incorrect that nothing was recovered from the alleged Room No.4 of the alleged building of Neeraj. I had not collected any rent deed from the owner of the building concerning the tenancy of the accused. I do not know the names of other tenants of the building. Ex.P-1/PW1 is not in my hand but in the hand of HC Dinesh. It is correct that my signature appear on it within red circle 'C'. The reference of Room No.5 on Ex.P-1/PW1 is wrongly mentioned. It is incorrect that it is a forged document as no such search was given. Room No.5 does not belong to accused Dheeraj. It is incorrect that even Room No.4 is not in the tenancy of accused Dheeraj. It is incorrect that no independent witness was associated for the actual search. It is incorrect that accused is falsely roped in this case being an outsider and an easy prey. It is incorrect that no information as alleged was received against the accused. I do not know who is Mintu and who is Guddu. It is incorrect that nothing incriminating was ever recovered from the possession of the accused. It is incorrect that I am deposing falsely.
