



Order below Exh. 01 In Pursuance of
Compromise Pursis at Exh. 11 and Mediation
Report Exh.12 in Reg. Civil Suit. No. 194 Of 2021

01] Perused roznama and record. It reveals that, defendants appeared sue-motu with permission of Court. Then the plaintiff and defendants are present before the Court along with their respective counsels. They have admitted contents of compromise terms (Exh.11), when read out to them and state that the suit is amicably settled between them as per the terms and conditions of said pursis.

02] Learned counsels of both sides have vehemently stated that, the suit is amicably settled out of Court as per the term of pursis. They have identified their respective parties. Hence, compromise pursis is read and recorded.

03] However, with the consent of both the parties the case had been referred to Hon'ble Trained Mediator, Ahmedpur for mediation. The Hon'ble mediator has submitted mediation report at (Exh.12). Therein stated that, the mediation had been carried out between the parties successfully by consulting with them. From the report of Hon'ble mediator below (Exh.12) and compromise pursis below (Exh.11) its asserting that suit has been amicable settlement between parties. In the circumstances, it would be necessary to compromise the suit as per terms of compromise pursis (Exh.11). Hence, I proceed to

pass following Order.

:- ORDER :-

- 1.** The suit stands disposed of as compromised as per provisions of Order XXIII Rule 1 read with Rule 3 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
- 2.** Decree be drawn up in terms of compromise pursis at (Exh.11).
- 3.** The compromise pursis at (Exh.11) be treated as a part of decree.
- 4.** Decree be sent to Sub-registrar office, Ahmedpur for compliance of vide Sec.89-A of Indian Registration Act,1908.
- 5.** No order as to costs.
- 6.** Issue Court Fees Refund certificate as per rules and procedure.
