At this stage, Ld. Counsel for complainant has appeared. He submitted that the court has committed an error by giving a date in his absence and cannot pass an order without hearing him. He submitted that he was only notified about his case in the evening on Monday. He submitted that he was present in KKD in the morning but had to rush for a doctors appointment and could not appear when the matter was called. He submitted that without hearing him the court is not entitled to pass any order. When the undersigned asked him to advance arguments on summoning he stated that he is not carrying the file.

He further submitted that he has been practicing since 1986 and in all the courts it is not the practice that the order is passed and dates are given in the pre-lunch session. The undersigned asked the Ld. Counsel for complainant to remain present prior to the lunch session on the NDOH, to this he submitted that this is not the case in any court and the convenience of counsels should be noted first. He further submitted that the date given is a very long date which is given in his absence and must be shortened. He further submitted that the counsel's convenience should be

accommodated first. He further submitted that giving date in the absence only be done by the Hon'ble High Courts and not by every court.

This matter is a fresh matter and was not listed for 02:00 PM. It was taken up as per the board before 01:00 PM and date was given.

This court is well within its power to give a date as per the court docket and pass the order as per law.

However, still considering the submission of Ld. Counsel for complainant and ensuring that the case is not prolonged the court, is inclined to shorten the date of this case.

Let the matter be listed for order on cognizance on **07.09.2026 at 02:00 PM.**

The previous date of 19.12.2026 stands cancelled.
