Present : Ld. Senior Advocate Sh. Ramesh Gupta along with Counsel Sh. Shailendra Singh for accused Rajinder Bharti along with Rajinder Bharti (*Physically*).

Accused Raghuvir Sharan Prajapati along with Counsel Sh. Manish Tiwari (*Physically*).

Proceedings against accused Savitri already **abated** vide order **dated 19.01.2019**.

Vakalatnama for Raghuvir Sharan Prajapati filed today.

Vakalatnama for Rajinder Bharti already filed on 14.11.2025 along with inspection application.

Today, an application has been filed on behalf of accused Rajinder Bharti to transfer the present case to the Court of competent jurisdiction, i.e. the Court of CJM/ACJM/JMFC, as all the offences under which the two accused have been charged are triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, so far as Delhi is concerned, as all those offences in Delhi are triable by such Courts.

At this stage, Sh. Anil Kumar Shukla, Ld. Counsel for the complainant appears (*Through VC*).

Sh. Manish Kumar Sharma, Ld. Special Prosecutor also appears (*Through VC*), and he also submits that he has already communicated to the concerned department of Government of Madhya Pradesh regarding the Prosecutor who would continue with the present

case in this Court, upon transfer of the case from Madhya Pradesh to Delhi. He submits that till the time that order is received, he will continue as Prosecutor in this matter.

Heard on the application filed by accused Rajinder Bharti today as to sending this matter to the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Put up for orders on that application on 20.11.2025.

Meanwhile, let a copy of this Order be sent to the concerned Law Secretary of the Government of State of Madhya Pradesh through the Resident Commissioner of Madhya Pradesh based at Delhi on an urgent basis as the State of Madhya Pradesh is required to appoint a Prosecutor in the present matter, after this matter was transferred under the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court from State of Madhya Pradesh to Delhi.

Meanwhile, the application U/s 197 Cr.P.C preferred by Raghuvir Sharan Prajapati is not heard as time is sought by the counsel for Raghuvir Sharan to argue on this application on the ground that he has been recently engaged and he has to go through the records which are in Hindi language as received from the Courts at Madhya Pradesh.

Put up on 20.11.2025 for orders on the application i.e. IA No. 2/2025 filed today. On the next date, the matter shall also come up for arguments on the application U/s 197 Cr.P.C under IA No. 1/2025.
