Proceedings against accused Savitri already **abated** vide
order **dated 19.01.2019**.

Today again the witness Deepak Belpatri is not present. Ld.
Counsel for accused Rajinder Bharti submitted that Deepak Belpatri is not
present today because on 06.02.2026 he was convicted in another matter
in Madhya Pradesh and he needs time for filing appeal in that case.

Admittedly, Deepak Belpatri has not been taken into custody
by the said Court in Madhya Pradesh. On the last date of hearing in this
Court, i.e. on 31.01.2026, Deepak Belpatri remained absent stating that he
had to appear in another Court on 06.02.2026 at Madhya Pradesh and it
was on his request that today's date of hearing was fixed. He was
specifically cautioned by this Court not to remain absent and not to delay
the matter, failing which coercive process shall have to be adopted against
him. When this court was inclined to issue coercive process against

Deepak Belpatri today, Mr. Santosh Chaurihaa counsel for Rajinder Bharti stated that he would ask Deepak Belpatri to appear through VC today and this Court may hear his request once before passing any orders. Thereafter, Deepak Belpatri appeared through VC and he also made a simple request for today. When his request did not appeal to this Court, and this Court was about to issue his NBWs, Deepak Belpatri said that this Court may fix any date in this week and he would definitely appear in this Court. He even offered to appear on 12.02.2026.

Keeping in view his request he is given one last opportunity to appear in this Court without coercive process on 12.02.2026 for his evidence, failing which this Court will have no other option left but to issue his NBWs to secure his presence. He has been made clear about this today again. And today again he has been cautioned not to try to delay the trial in any manner, particularly, since it is a time bound matter and also since the earlier conduct of this witness before this court as well as before the Court in MP is indicative that he does not appear without coercive process issued against him, repeatedly. One last opportunity is given.

Put up for evidence of Deepak Belpatri on 12.02.2026, followed by the evidence of both the accused on 13.02.2026.

Both the accused are directed once again to remain physically present on 13.02.2026 and no exemption shall be entertained and they are also cautioned not to try to delay the trial in any manner, failing which consequences would follow.
