This petition came up before me for hearing today in the presence of counsels M/s. M.P. Muguntharajan, A. Logesh, E. Sridhar, M. Sathiyamoorthy, R. Rajkumar, A. Pooja, appearing for the petitioner/Accused and Thiru. E.L.Kannan, the Public Prosecutor for the respondent/Prosecution, on perusal of reply submitted by Prosecution and upon hearing the arguments from the counsels on both side, upon perusing the entire records of the case, this Court passed the following:-

ORDER

The petitioner who was arrested on 11.03.2026 for commission of alleged offences under Section 126(2), 296(b), 118(1), 109(1) of BNS r/w Sec. 4 of TNPHW Act has filed the present petition seeking Bail under section.483 of the BNSS, 2023.

The learned counsel for the petitioner /accused has filed the present bail

application on the ground that no offence as stated by the prosecution has taken place. She would state that the defacto complainant herein and voluntarily called the petitioner/accused. While so, the occurrence took place due to the quarrel between the both parties. She would state that the petitioner/accused is ready to co-operate with the investigation agency and that he is in custody since 11.03.2026. On these grounds she would pray for grant of bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor on behalf of the respondent police would strongly oppose for the grant of bail on the ground that the petitioner/accused is said to have assaulted the defacto complainant with knife and caused grievous injury due to which the present case came to be registered. She has initially taken treatment after discharge she is continuously taking treatment till date and tension prevails in the area and the investigation is pending in a preliminary stage and he would strongly oppose for grant of bail.

Heard the parties concerned and perused the relevant records. In this case, considering the the nature of the injuries and the preliminary stage of investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail. Hence the bail application is dismissed.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
