This petition came up before me for hearing today in the presence of counsels M/s. S. Sathiya, P. Sathyanarayanan, N. Arjunan, B. Balaji, B. Aravindhan, appearing for the Respondent/Accused and Thiru. V. Bharathi, the Public Prosecutor for the Petitioner/Complainant, on perusal of reply submitted by Prosecution and upon hearing the arguments from the counsels on both side, upon perusing the entire records of the case, this Court passed the following:-

ORDER

Petition filed by the prosecution to cancel the bail granted to the respondent/accused vide order dated 17.02.2026 in Crl.M.P. No. 347 of 2026.

2. The learned Public Prosecutor would contend as follows. The petitioner is the husband of the defacto complainant. The defacto complainant has lodged a complaint state that the respondent/accused used to suspect her character and the

petitioner assaulted the defacto complainant by using knife and caused grievous injury and the respondent was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 28.01.2026 , subsequently this court has granted bail to the respondent with certain conditions vide order dated 17.02.2026 in CrI.M.P.No. 347/2026 and the respondent has misused the liberty granted by this court. Hence, that the bail be cancelled.

3. The learned counsel for the respondent/ accused would contend as follows. The petitioner/ complainant falsely registered the above case in Cr.No. 35/2026 against the respondent alleging that he has committed an offence based on the false complaint given by his wife. It is stated that the respondent was granted bail by this court and after his release he was regularly complying the condition imposed by this court. It is stated that there was a family dispute between them and they are still residing together in the same house for more than one month in a peaceful manner without any disputes. Further the respondent has not violated any of the conditions of the bail order of this court. Hence, that the petition has to be dismissed.

4. The defacto complainant was present today and she expressed that since the petitioner accepted the arrogant behavior on the intoxication of alcohol, she was forced to lodged the complainant subsequently which made the police filed this application for cancellation of bail. The petitioner also present before this court and assured with he will not torcher the defacto complainant being his wife. Regarding the above submissions, the application for cancellation of bail is dismissed at present with the observations that the petitioner shall not threatened or abused in any way the

defacto complainant the petitioner voluntarily accepted that he will given Rs. 500/- daily to the defacto complainant for basic livelihood purpose. In the event of any violation of conditions, the defacto complainant is at liberty to alleged a fresh complainant and at the same time the prosecution is also given a free hand to file the another cancellation of bail application the fact that the earlier application being dismissed.

5. In result, this petition is dismissed.
