COMMON ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATIONS

Perused bail application and say. Heard both side. Accused have alleged to have commit offence under Sections 318(4), 319(2), 336(2), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 3(5) of BNS and Sections 66(c) and 66(d) of I.T. Act.

2. It is case of cyber fraud for aforesaid mentioned Sections. The total cyber fraud amount is Rs.37,50,999/-. Out of said amount Rs.6,25,425/- transferred to account of this accused. Accused deposited Rs.6,00,000/- before this court by filing an application thereunder he will not reclaim it. In view of this mitigating circumstance, bail is granted on following conditions-

ORDER

1. Criminal Bail application No. 2023/2026 is allowed.
2. Accused is released on furnishing P.B. and S.B. of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only). Provisional Cash bail of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) is allowed for two weeks from this order.
3. All accused shall furnish only one local surety for them in the like amount.
4. Accused shall not make any contact to the informant and shall not indulge in any type of offence.
5. The applicant/Accused shall attend concerned police station till completion of trial as and when called by I.O. for investigation.
6. The applicant/Accused shall submit verified copy of his eAadhar Card as well as other address proof along with his mobile number.

7. The applicant/Accused is further directed to submit a list of at least three local blood relatives with their detail residential addresses with documentary proof of showing the correctness of the details produced by them.
8. The applicant/Accused is also directed that he and his local sureties should submit copies of at least two documents amongst their respective Passport, PAN Card, eAadhar Card, Electricity Bill, Landline Telephone Bill, Voter I.D. Card issued by the Election Commission of India and Property Tax Register while furnishing the bail.
9. The applicant/Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner and shall not indulge in any type of criminal activity. If it is noticed that he involved in such type of offence the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation for bail.
10. The applicant/Accused shall not change the place of residence without prior intimation to the concerned police station.
11. Any observation made in this order is made only for limited purpose of deciding this bail application and it shall not come in the way of trial during the trial.
12. Criminal Bail Application No. 2023/2026 is disposed of accordingly.
