The de facto complainant has appeared before the Court and has passed a pursis stating that he has no objection if the case is disposed and the accused is exonerated. It transpires from the said pursis that the de facto complainant wishes to compound the case. The offence alleged is a compoundable one. Therefore, in view of the pursis passed by the de facto complainant, the accused shall stand acquitted keeping the section 320(1) & 320 (8) of the CrPC.

Furthermore, the SHO of the concerned police station is ordered that whenever a better claimant approaches the police station seeking custody of stolen property and if the same is recovered and available with the police station, then, it shall handed over to the claimant after verifying credentials *qua* identity and ownership of the claimant.
