ORDER

The Petitioner/ Plaintiff prays that this Honorable court may be pleased to order for arrest against the 2nd Respondent in order to realize the decree amount Rs.70,099.95/- under order 21 Rule 37 and 38 and section 151 of CPC and render justice.

No representation for DH. Decree Holder called absent since calling till 01.15 PM E.P of the year 2018. E. P is pending for arrest of JD since 14.11.2018. On several occasions batta was not paid or returned. Even today the batta filed has been returned. As Sufficient opportunity already granted for due progress of the arrest, the DH had failed to utilize the opportunities.

Hence, it appears that the Decree Holder is not inclined to proceed with the EP. This court is of the considered view that the Decree Holder is not interested to proceed with the EP. In the result, this Execution Petition is closed.
