JUDGEMENT

Suit for permanent injunction.

2. On admission of suit, summons were issued to the defendant. The defendants appeared before this court but did not file written statement. Therefore, the defendant were set ex-parte.

3. The plaintiff has filed proof affidavit and examined himself as PW1 and marked Ex A1 and Ex A2 on his side. Plaintiff side argument. Heard.

4.The plaintiff is in possession and enjoyment of the suit property which is evident from Ex A1 patta and Ex A2 chitta and adangal. The defendant is attempting to interfere with the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit property which is evident from plaint pleadings and evidence of PW1. Claim proved.

5. As the defendant in this case remained ex-parte, there is no contra pleadings to the contentions of the plaintiff and the plaintiff's contention as against defendant stands proved. In the above circumstances, this court is inclined to grant the relief claimed by the plaintiff as against the defendant.

6. In the result, the suit is decreed as prayed for in the plaint with cost.
