COMMITMENT ORDER:

The above named accused has been sent up for facing trial by
the Station House Officer, Police Station Mahesh Nagar for the alleged
commission of offences punishable under Section 140(3), 316(2), 318(4),
61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (*hereinafter to be referred in*

short as “BNS”) & 24 Immigration Act (hereinafter to be referred in short as “BNS”).

2. The present prosecution case has been registered on the complaint of complainant Gurpreet Singh, who has deposed that accused Kuldeep Singh and Gulab Singh, Sarpanch, were known to his father as agents for sending persons abroad. They were running an office under the name and style of “Kuldeep Singh & Gulab Singh Travel Agent.” His father had contacted the aforesaid persons for sending him abroad. They represented that they would send Gurpreet Singh to the USA for a consideration of ₹55,00,000/-. They further represented that, before sending him to the USA, they would initially send him on a tourist visa and thereafter arrange a work permit for him. That on 13.06.2024, he was granted asylum at the airport itself. A Pakistani national, who was having his photograph, came to receive him at the airport. On the basis of the photograph, he identified the complainant and took him to a hotel. Thereafter, they demanded a further amount of ₹20,00,000/- for taking him further. He somehow managed to arrange ₹20,00,000/- from his family. After receiving the said amount, he was taken by taxi towards Panama and Guatemala. On the way, he was beaten by the persons accompanying him and was kept hostage. While he was being held hostage, the accused/persons accompanying him demanded the remaining amount from his family and told him that “we will release you only if

your family pays us.” He accordingly contacted his family and asked them to arrange the demanded amount. However, due to delay on the part of his family in arranging the money, he was beaten mercilessly and was kept without food and water. Hence, it is prayed that legal action may kindly be taken against the accused. On the basis of this complaint of the complainant, a formal FIR was registered. Statements of witnesses were recorded. Accused was arrested. After completion of all the formalities of investigation, challan under section 193 BNSS was prepared and submitted in the court for trial.

3. On the basis of the aforesaid complaint of complainant, present FIR was registered against aforesaid accused. Thereafter, investigation was commenced. During investigation, statements of witnesses under Section 180 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*hereinafter to be referred in short as “BNSS”*) were recorded. During investigation, on finding incriminating evidence against aforesaid accused, he was arrested in accordance with law and his Disclosure Statement was recorded; thereafter, he was produced before the Court, who was ordered by the Court to be kept in judicial custody. Upon completion of usual formalities of investigation, Final Police Report/Challan was prepared against accused and forwarded in the Court for commencement of trial against him.

4. Thereafter, Copy of Final Police Report/Challan under

Section 193 of BNSS. and accompanied documents were supplied to accused, free of cost, as contemplated under Section 230 of BNSS.

5. This Court has carefully heard learned APP for the State and learned defence counsel and has also gone through the material brought on record in its entirety.

6. During the investigation of the present case, prosecution has collected sufficient evidence and had presented the Final Police Report/Challan against the accused for commission of offences punishable under Section 140(3), 316(2), 318(4), 61(2) BNS of 24 Immigration Act. From Final Police Report/Challan under Section 193 of BNSS. and the material collected during the investigation, at this stage, it appears that accused has committed the alleged offences.

7. Since offence punishable under Section 140 (3) of BNS is exclusively triable by learned Court of Sessions, **present case is hereby committed to the Court of Sessions, Ambala for 18.08.2026.** In compliance of Section 232 of BNSS., accused in judicial custody, be remanded to judicial custody during and until the conclusion of the trial subject to the provisions of bail provided in BNSS. and be produced before Hon'ble Sessions Court, Ambala on the date fixed i.e. **18.08.2026 at 10:00 a.m. sharp.**

8. Learned Public Prosecutor stands notified accordingly through learned Assistant Public Prosecutor of this Court of the aforesaid
