This is a petition filed by the petitioner u/s.483 of BNSS., seeking bail.

This petition coming on for final hearing before me today in the presence of Thiru.M. Senthilkumar, advocate for the petitioner and of Thiru. N. Senthilkumar, Public Prosecutor appearing for the state and upon hearing the arguments of both sides and having stood over for consideration till this day, this Court has passed the following.

O R D E R

Heard both sides.

The petitioner/accused is seeking bail for the offences alleged to have been committed by him u/s.296(b), 118(2) and 109 of BNS Act r/w. Sec.4 of TNPHW Act concerned in Cr.No.62/2026 of Vengamedu P.S.,

The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that in fact this petitioner is no way connected with the alleged offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. This petitioner is in judicial custody since 03.03.2026. He prays to release him on bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor submits that the petitioner is the sole accused in this case. He states that the defacto complainant is the mother of the victim viz.Karthiga. He states that the said Karthiga and her husband viz.Jeyabaskar were running a computer service center at Pasupathipalayam and the petitioner herein is the neighbour to the said shop and he is running a RO Machine shop. In this circumstances, the petitioner has harassed the said Karthiga and demanded her to marry him. When the same was refused by the said Karthiga, on 02.03.2026, the petitioner has went to house of the said Karthiga and he scolded the said Karthiga and her husband Jeyabaskar with filthy language and also assaulted the said Jeyabaskar with billhook on his left side of his cheeks, head, left shoulder, left side hips, left side thighs and caused grievous injuries and when the same was

prevented by the said Karthiga, the petitioner has also assaulted her with billhook on her hands and as a result, her three fingers were chopped off. The injured has been discharged from the hospital. He states that the investigation in this case is pending and if the petitioner is released on bail, it would cause prejudice to the further course of the investigation and hence, he objected to release him on bail.

It is seen that the petitioner has harassed the daughter of the defacto complainant viz. Karthiga and demanded her to marry him and when the same was refused by the said Karthiga, on 02.03.2026, the petitioner has went to house of the said Karthiga and he scolded the said Karthiga and her husband Jeyabaskar with filthy language and also assaulted the said Jeyabaskar with billhook on his left side of his cheeks, head, left shoulder, left side hips, left side thighs and caused grievous injuries and when the same was prevented by the said Karthiga, the petitioner has also assaulted her with billhook on her hands and as a result, her three fingers were chopped off.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of the offence, the investigation is pending, even though the injured has been discharged from the hospital, since the injury caused by the petitioner is grievous in nature and the weapon used, I am of the view that granting bail to this petitioner would cause prejudice to the further course of investigation and hence, I am not inclined to allow this petition.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
