This petition coming on for final hearing before me today in the presence of Thiru P.K.Vaitheeswaran, advocate for the petitioner and of Thiru. N. Senthilkumar, Public Prosecutor appearing for the state and upon hearing the arguments of both sides and having stood over for consideration till this day, this Court has passed the following.

ORDER

This is a petition filed by the petitioner u/s.483(ii) of BNSS., seeking condition relaxation.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court has granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.198/2026 dated 23.02.2026 with condition that he should sign before respondent/police daily at 10.00 a.m., and 6.00 p.m., for about 15 days. He states that the petitioner/ accused is observing the condition regularly on and from 02.03.2026 to till date without fail. He further states that the petitioner is the District President of Bharathiya Janatha Party and due to the upcoming assembly election and frequent travel for party work, he finds it difficult to comply with the condition. He therefore prays to relax the condition.

The learned Public Prosecutor submits that the petitioner has been regularly complying with the condition on and from 02.03.2026 to till date without fail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of the offences and the fact that the petitioner/accused is complying the condition regularly to till date without fail, I inclined to relax the condition totally. This petition is allowed and the condition imposed on the petitioner/accused is relaxed totally.
