This petition coming on for final hearing before me today in the presence of Thiru T. Balasubramani, advocate for the petitioner and of Thiru. N. Senthilkumar, Public Prosecutor appearing for the state and upon hearing the arguments of both sides and having stood over for consideration till this day, this Court has passed the following.

ORDER

This is a petition filed by the petitioner u/s.483(ii) of BNSS., seeking condition modification.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court has granted bail to the petitioner in CrI.M.P.No.181/2026 dated 19.02.2026 with condition that he should sign before the respondent/police daily at 10.00 a.m., and 6.00 p.m., for about 15 days. He states that the petitioner/ accused is observing the condition regularly from 03.03.2026 to till date without fail. He further states that the petitioner is living and working in Coimbatore and so, he finds it difficult to comply with the condition. He therefore prays to modify the condition.

The learned Public Prosecutor submits that the petitioner has been regularly complying with the condition from 03.03.2026 to till date without fail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of the offences and the fact that, the condition is imposed only for a period of 15 days and the petitioner/accused has complied with the condition only for six days, I am of the view that if this petition is allowed and the condition is modified, the investigation will be prejudiced and hence, I am not inclined to modify the condition.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
