ORDER

Heard both sides.

The petitioner/accused is seeking bail for the offences alleged to have been committed by him u/s.316(2), 318(3), 318(4) of BNS Act concerned in Cr.No.1100/2025 of Karur Town P.S.,

The learned counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that in fact this petitioner is no way connected with the alleged offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. This petitioner is in judicial custody since 03.02.2026. He prays to release him on bail.

The date of alleged occurrence of offence is on 19.02.2025. The date of FIR is on 24.12.2025. The petitioner has filed this petition on 11.03.2026. Further, on 17.03.2026, 18.03.2026 and on 23.03.2026 there was no representation on the side of the petitioner. Therefore, for the past three hearing there was no representation on the side of the petitioner. Hence, the petition is dismissed.

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In the result, the petition is dismissed.
