The applicant/accused prayed for his release on bail under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) in connection with C. R. No. 370 of 2026 registered with Ambad Police Station for the offences punishable under sections 310(4) and 310(5) of the BNS, 4 read with 25 of the Arms Act and 135 of the Maharashtra Police Act.

02] The survey of prosecution case would reveal that the informant Sandeep Dilip Bhure, Police Constable attached to Ambad Police Station lodged complaint *inter alia* alleging that on 22.03.2026, at about 09.00 p.m. while he was on night patrolling duty, received a secret tip in respect of purported activities of applicant. Accordingly, the informant formed a team and they

proceeded towards Fadol mala, Ekdant nagar, Nashik where they have presence of around 5 to 6 persons in a suspicious condition. They were armed with deadly weapons. On inquiry with them, they started running away. However, with the help of police staffs, they could apprehend the present applicants from the spot. On inquiry with them, they have disclosed their intent to commit dacoity and also disclosed the names of the co-accused, who fled away from the spot and on taking their personal search, articles like knife, hammer, saw, iron hook, mask, hand-gloves, rope, handkerchief, chilly powder, bag, sickle, wooden log, iron rod and two motor cycles were recovered at their instance. Hence, the complaint.

03]           The bail is prayed mainly on the ground that recitals of the FIR would reveal that no specific role has been attributed to the present applicant and he has been apprehended on the basis of information supplied by the co-accused. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered at the instance of the present applicant and he is behind bar since 06.04.2026 and his further custodial interrogation would not serve any purpose. Hence, prayed for release on bail.

04]           The respondent-state has resisted the application by filing reply at Ex. 4 *inter alia* contending that the applicant was accompanied with the co-accused. They conspired to commit dacoity and accordingly, they were arrested while preparing/attempting to commit dacoity. It is further stated that the investigation is in progress and in the event of arrest, it would hamper the progress of investigation. Hence, prayed for rejection

of the bail.

05] Having heard Ld. Advocate for the respective parties, it is evident from the record that present applicant came to be arrested almost after 14 days of the incident on the basis of information supplied by co-accused whilst in custody. Admittedly, nothing has been recovered at the instance of the applicant. The applicant has no criminal antecedent to his discredit and it further appears that his further custody would not serve any purpose. Hence, the application deserves to be allowed in terms of order below :

### **ORDER**

- 01] Criminal Bail Application No. 624 of 2026 is allowed.
- 02] The applicant/accused namely Akshay Sanjay Kshirsagar be released on executing P. B. and S. B. of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand) with one or two solvent surety/ies of like amount in connection with C. R. No. 370 of 2026 registered with Ambad Police Station for the offences punishable under sections 310(4) and 310(5) of the BNS, 4 read with 25 of the Arms Act and 135 of the Maharashtra Police Act on following conditions:
  - a) He shall report concern Police Station on every Monday in between 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. till conclusion of the investigation and filing of charge-sheet.
  - b) He shall not indulge in the similar offences and shall maintain calm and peace.
  - c) He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat, promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the

Court or any police officer.

**d)** He shall not tamper the Prosecution witnesses.

**e)** In the event of breach of any of the conditions as narrated above without any further order, the liberty granted to the above applicant shall stands cancelled.

03] Criminal Bail Application No. 624 of 2026 stands disposed of accordingly.
