The petitioner filed this petition Under Sections 140, 141,163(A) & 166 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Rule 3 of the Tamil Nadu Motor Accident Claims Tribunal praying that directing the respondents to pay Rs.5,00,000/- as compensation with interest from the date of the petition till the date of realization with cost.

This Petition is coming in the presence of Thiru.K.Senthilkumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and 1st respondent remained exparte and Thiru.S.Manivannan, learned counsel for the 2nd respondent and upon hearing the both side argument and on perusal of entire materials placed before me this Tribunal passed the following:-

DECRETAL ORDER

1. The Petitioner is awarded **Rs.3,99,347/- (Rupees Three Lakhs, ninety nine thousand, three hundred and forty seven Only)** together with interest at 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit.
2. The 2nd respondent shall pay a sum of **Rs.3,99,347/- (Rupees Three Lakhs, ninety nine thousand, three hundred and forty seven Only)** to the petitioner on behalf of the 1st respondent.
3. The award amount shall be deposited within one month from the date of order by NEFT/RTGS mode directly into the account standing in the name of the **CJMKRURMCOP17821 IFSC.No.IOBA0000738 Thanthonimalai** under intimation to this Tribunal by way of submitting pay advice slip.
4. The petitioner is hereby directed to furnish a copy of the first page of Bank pass book of himself, which compulsorily contain the photograph of the petitioner duly attested by the bank concerned, self attested copy of the pan card if available, to this

Tribunal, with in a period of one month from today for the deposit of award amount in his bank account, failing which the petitioner is not entitled to withdraw the award amount.

5. The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the amount on deposit.

6. The Advocate fee is fixed at **Rs.4000/-**

7. The petitioner shall pay the balance court fee of **Rs.2,993/-** within 15 days from the date of this order.

8. On such payment only the decretal order for the Petitioner shall be provided.

09. That the respondent do pay a sum of **Rs.7,376/-** to the petitioner being the cost of a petition. **(Cost list not filed)**
