The petitioner filed this petition Under Sections 140 & 166 of Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and Rule 3(1) of Tamil Nadu Motor Accident Claims Tribunal Rules 1989 Act praying that directing the respondents to pay Rs.10,00,000/- as compensation with interest from the date of the petition till the date of realization with cost.

This Petition is coming on 29.04.2025 in the presence of Thiru. P.Rameshkumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and respondents remain exparte and upon hearing the petitioner side argument and on perusal of entire materials placed before me this Tribunal passed the following,

**DECRETAL ORDER**

1. The Petitioner is awarded **Rs.1,18,000/- (Rupees One eighteen thousand only)** together with interest at 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit.
2. The 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent shall pay a sum of **Rs.1,18,000/- (Rupees One eighteen thousand only)** to the petitioner on behalf of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent.
3. The award amount shall be deposited within one month from the date of order by NEFT / RTGS mode directly into the account standing in the name of the CJMKRURMCOP74221 IFSC.No.IOBA0000738 Thanthonimalai under intimation to this Tribunal by way of submitting pay advice slip.
4. The petitioner is hereby directed to furnish a copy of the first page of Bank pass book of himself, which compulsorily contain the photograph of the petitioner duly attested by the bank concerned, self attested copy of the pan card if available, to this Tribunal, with in a period of one month from today for the deposit of award amount in his bank account, failing which the petitioner is not entitled to withdraw the award amount.
5. The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the amount on deposit.
6. The Advocate fee is fixed at **Rs.4,000/-**.
7. The petitioner shall pay the balance court fee of **Rs.180/-** within 15 days from the date of this order.

8. On such payment only the decretal order for the Petitioner shall be Provided.
9. No amount shall be deducted towards TDS in the award amount.
10. That the respondent do pay a sum of **Rs.4,802.50/-** to the petitioner being the cost of a petition. **(Cost list filed on 17.06.2025)**
