1. Both the parties are represented by their respective engaged counsels.

2. Judgment is made ready, delivered in open court and the formally prepared Judgment is appended to this case record.

3. The claim petition is allowed by awarding Rs.65,42,152/- (Rupees Sixty Five Lakhs Forty Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty Two) only to the claimants payable by OP No.3, IFFCO General Insurance Company Ltd. and OP No.6, Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd. jointly and severally. Therefore, the OP No.3, IFFCO General Insurance Company Ltd. and OP No.6, Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd. are directed to pay 50% of the awarded amount each, to the claimants within 30 days from today along with interest at the rate of 7% per annum on the total compensation amount from the date of filing of the case till realization.

4. Out of the total awarded amount, the claimant No.2 being a married daughter of the deceased is only entitled to receive the filial consortium amount of Rs.48,400/- (Rupees Forty Eight Thousand Four Hundred) only.

5. The above awarded amount shall preferably be deposited in the Account

6. In view of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme court of India, it is mandatory to deposit a portion of the awarded sum in fixed deposit. Accordingly, for protection of the awarded money in compliance of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, 70% of the awarded amount shall be kept in fixed deposit in the name of the claimants No.1, No.3 and No.4 for 3 (three) years and remaining 30% shares shall be received by them in equal shares.

7. An authenticated copy of the award shall be forwarded to the OP No.3, IFFCO General Insurance Company Ltd. and OP No.6, Reliance General Insurance Company Ltd. by E-mail by the dealing/concerned Assistant of this Tribunal in terms of the order dated 16th March, 2021 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 534/2020.

8. This case is disposed of on contest.
