This e-petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.R.Nagendran, Advocate for the petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Anticipatory Bail application u/s 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS).

2. Heard both sides.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners/accused would submit that the respondent police registered a case against the petitioners and others in Cr.No.227/2016 for the offences u/s 341, 294(b), 307 & 324 of IPC. The petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offences as alleged. It is a case of year 2016. Investigation is completed and charge sheet is also filed. Custodial interrogation of petitioners is not necessary. The petitioners have not filed similar petition before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court or any other court. The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of police and they are ready to abide by any conditions that would be imposed by this court and prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor submitted that totally there are 4 accused in this case and the petitioners are A3 and A4. As per the case of the prosecution, due to previous enmity, on 13.07.2016 at 10.15 p.m., A1 to A4 have wrongfully restrained the defacto-complainant, abused him in vulgar words and assaulted him brutally with Aruval and caused injuries at his left hand and fled the scene of occurrence. Hence, the complaint. Injured discharged from hospital on 20.07.2016. Investigation is completed and Absconding charge sheet filed and the case taken on file as PRC No.56/2025 pending on the file of Judicial Magistrate, Tirumangalam at committal stage and left the matter to the discretion of the court.

5. Rival contentions are taken into consideration. The alleged offences against the petitioners /accused are u/s 341, 294(b), 307 & 324 of IPC. The occurrence is said to have taken place on 13.07.2016. Injured discharged from hospital on 20.07.2016. It is represented on the side of prosecution that **investigation is completed** and Absconding charge sheet filed and the case taken on file as PRC No.56/2025 pending on the file of Judicial Magistrate, Tirumangalam at committal stage. It is mentioned in the petition that the petitioners No.1 and 2 are residing in Perungudi and Madurai City respectively. No proper explanation offered on prosecution side for non-arresting the accused. Case is now pending at committal stage. No purpose would be served in remanding them. Considering all these aspects and the stage of case, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners on conditions.

In the result, in the event of arrest or on their surrendering before the Court concerned the petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, Tirumangalam subject to the following conditions:-

(i) The petitioners shall surrender before the Court concerned within 15 days from today without fail.

(ii) The petitioner shall appear before court concerned on receipt of summons and the petitioner shall co-operate for the quick committal of the case and he shall not threaten the witnesses.

(iii) If there is any violation of condition, the Investigation Officer is within his discretion to approach the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate, concerned for cancellation of bail even though bail granted by the Sessions Court as per the ruling of the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in **P.K.Shaji/Vs/State of Kerala, (2005) AIR S.C.W.5560.**
