This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.P.S.Nagarajan, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition to relax the Condition.
2. The offences alleged are u/s 326(g), 105 of BNS, 9(B)(1)(b) & 12 of Indian Explosives Act and 3 & 5 of Explosive Substances Act.
3. Heard both sides.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this Court as per order in Cr.L.M.P.No.5291/2025 dated 21.11.2025 on conditions to appear and sign before the Inspector of police, respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner is complying with the said condition for more than 100 days. Investigation is almost completed. The petitioner is the only earning member in his family and he finds it difficult to comply with the condition. Hence it is prayed to relax the condition. The learned Public Prosecutor Prosecutor has not denied the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner and he further stated that charge sheet is not yet filed. Considering the above said facts, the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner and the reasons assigned by the petitioner, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed against the petitioner totally.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition is totally relaxed. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Court on summons and co-operate with the court for early disposal of the case.
