This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.S.Mayalagu, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

**Order**

1. Petition to relax the Condition.
2. The offences alleged are u/s 406, 420, 468 & 471 of IPC.
3. Heard both sides.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by this court as per order in CrI.M.P.No.422/2026 dated 20.02.2026 on conditions to appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner is regularly complying with the said condition for the past 16 days. The petitioner is the only earning member in his family and he finds it difficult to comply with the condition. Investigation is almost completed. Hence, it is prayed to relax the condition. The learned Public Prosecutor has not denied the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioner and he further stated that investigation is not yet completed and objected to relax the condition. Considering the above facts, the involvement of huge amount, the non- completion of investigation, the nature of

offences and the objections placed on the side of prosecution, this court is not inclined to relax the condition.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
