This petition coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.M.Ayyanar, Advocate for the petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

Order

1. Petition to relax the Condition.

2. The offences alleged are u/s 498(A), 294(b), 120(B) and 506(i) of IPC.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this court as per order in CrI.M.P.No.5734/2025 dated 16.12.2025 on conditions to appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners regularly complied with the condition for 21 days and thereafter the said condition was modified as per order in Cr.M.P.No.203/2026 dated 19.01.2026 directing the petitioners to appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, respondent police station weekly once i.e. on every Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners are regularly complying with the said modified condition for the past 7weeks. The petitioners are the only earning member in their family and they find it difficult to comply with the condition. Investigation is completed. Hence, it is prayed to relax the condition. The learned Public Prosecutor has not denied the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioners and he further stated

that charge sheet is not yet filed. Considering the above said facts, the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioners and the reasons assigned by the petitioners, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed against the petitioners totally.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition is totally relaxed. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Court on summons and co-operate with the court for early disposal of the case.
