These petitions coming on today for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.R.Prakash, Advocate for the petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for the State, this court passed the following:

**Order**

1. Petition to relax the Condition.

2. The offences alleged are u/s 296(b), 351(2) of BNS and 4 of TNPWH Act.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were granted anticipatory bail by this court as per order in CrI.M.P.No.546/2026 dated 06.02.2026 on conditions to appear and sign before the Inspector of Police, respondent police station daily at 10.00 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. until further orders. The petitioners are regularly complying with the said condition for the past 14 days. Both the petitioners are employees and that abiding condition twice a day affects their work and hence, it is prayed to relax the condition. To substantiate the same, copy of their employee identity cards were produced for perusal. The learned Public Prosecutor has not denied the number of days of compliance of condition by the petitioners and he further stated that charge sheet is not yet filed. Considering the above said facts, the number of days of compliance of condition by the

petitioners, the nature of offences and the reasons assigned by the petitioners, this court is inclined to relax the condition imposed against the petitioners totally.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the condition is totally relaxed. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Court on summons and co-operate with the court for early disposal of the case.
