In this Bail Petition Advocate M/s.Tajudeen has appeared for the Petitioner/Accused and the Thiru.K.S.Murali, Learned Public Prosecutor has appeared for the Respondent, that this petition came up for final hearing before me 18.03.2026 and on perusing the records having stood over for consideration of this court till this day, this court delivers today he following,

ORDER

- 1.This petition is filed under Sec 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS).
2. That the petitioner /accused has been arrested in execution of NBW and remanded to Judicial Custody on 21.01.2026.
3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has that the petitioner has appeared the court regularly and that on 27.10.2025 due to his non appearance warrant has been issued and he is arrested and produced before this court on 21.01.2026. That the non appearance is not willful and submit that the petitioner is the bread winner of the family and if released on bail he will abide any condition.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that the accused is remanded on execution of NBW that there are 3 cases against the petitioner if the petitioner is released on bail he will abscond and prayed to dismiss the petition.

5. On perusal of the record it appears that charges framed and the case is posted for trial and for non appearance of the petitioner NBW is issued and the accused is arrested and remanded in Judicial custody on 21.01.2026 and he is in jail for more than 56 days witness yet to be produced and completion of trial will take time. Under this circumstances on considering that the petitioner is said to be the bread winner of the family and he under take to abide any condition this court is of the view that the petitioner may be ordered to be released on bail on stringent condition.

1. The petitioner shall execute a bond for sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the same amount to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate No.II, Usilampatti.

2. That the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Usilampatti every Monday and singed at 10.30 a.m. and shall appear for future hearings without fail.

3. That the petitioner shall not commit similar offence.

4. That the petitioner shall not tamper evidence.

5. That the petitioner shall furnish contact cell number for official communication

Accordingly this petition is allowed.
